## 6. Local Community (intended for country preschools)

  - The centre is situated in McLaren Vale in the Onkaparinga Council which is a semi-rural wine growing area. Families using this centre come from a variety of Anglo Saxon and multicultural backgrounds. It has a growing number of single parent families and the majority of parents are working or studying.
- Parent and community involvement in the preschool
  - :The community and parents are strongly involved in the centre management and show an interest in the children's progress and development. Staff aim for "partnerships" with parents, not just superficial parental involvement.
